

An Index to Sheldon's Account Book 1586-1588

This mildly idiosyncratic index is a somewhat rough guide to the content of the account book 1586-88, CR 2632. The variety of ways in which men were referred to may mean that the indexer has amalgamated some characters who should have remained separate; it is advisable to check all the entries for the same name and reach your own judgement. Variant spellings too make identification difficult. Most references appear under the modern spelling, cross-referenced to that in the manuscript.

Ralph Sheldon is so frequently mentioned that it becomes meaningless to list every occasion. Place names are best found from the diary of his journeys [Sheldon's Journeys \(ralphsheldon1537-1613.info\)](#)

Alternative spellings – usually collected together under modern spelling

Names where the transcriber was unable to read part of the name, usually the surname, have been listed as GAP. None is a man of consequence.
